Press Release: Grant Parish District Performance Scores

The Louisiana Department of Education released the most recent District and School performance data on Wednesday, November 16. Here are some highlights from Grant Parish.

Grant Parish's District Performance score rose by 4.5 points from an 80.5 (B) in 2021 to an 85.1 (B) in 2022. This demonstrates the fifth highest growth in the state and Grant Parish's overall DPS ranks 15th in the state. It is the fourth consecutive time Grant Parish's DPS increased since the current formula was implemented in 2018.

The average District Performance score was 77.1 in the state of Louisiana. The average for growth was 2.3 points for all Louisiana schools. The average growth for Louisiana elementary/middle schools increased by 3 points, combination schools increased 1.4 points, and on average state high schools decreased by .1 points.

We are proud to report that Grant Parish Schools surpassed the state averages in growth. All Grant Parish Schools attained growth in their SPS from the previous year. The average growth for our schools was 5.8 points. Grant Parish elementary/middle schools increased by 7 points, combination schools increased by 4.9 points and high schools increased by 2 points.

I want to thank the administrators, teachers, and staff of all our schools and the central office for their hard work and dedication to the children of our parish. I also want to say thank you to the parents, guardians and community members for their continued support of our schools. The gains we have made since the pandemic are to be commended and celebrated. We will continue to work together to make everyone proud of the schools in Grant Parish.
